***YOU SHOULD START BUILDING
DECKS ON THE SIDE***



“I didn’t start doing this kind of work so I could shuffle papers and make phone calls. I want to work with my hands.”

So if one guy has an emergency or needs to go get a missing part, it pushes back the whole project, and torpedoes your bottom line in the process. **When you factor in the time loss and opportunity cost, that \$5 part becomes a \$500 part in a hurry.**

And if you run a bigger company, that comes with its own challenges. You had to work hard to get to where you are, earning trust with your subcontractors and building a reputation on your solid craftsmanship. **Only now, you're not "crafting" anything.** You oversee the boots on the ground, out there on the job site having all the fun, while you're stuck inside managing project schedules, filling out paperwork and balancing budgets. Is this why you started the company?

Even if you're a smaller business, you still face the challenge of all that time you spend estimating projects and going out for looks & bids. You'll go out to look at what seems like a simple kitchen job. It's in an older neighborhood, so you know there'll be some surprises in the walls. When you do your inspection, you see some structural problems and your estimate goes up. The only problem is that your competitor who came in here earlier didn't notice, and his quote was lower, so now the homeowner's looking at you with one eyebrow raised, not sure who to trust

And there goes several hours of windshield time, wasted on a project you were doomed to lose from the start.

What if you didn't have to deal with all of this? What if there were a way to get back to working with your hands, by yourself - without a bunch of different subcontractors holding up your schedule and stepping on your toes at the job site?

If you've never done a deck project before - here are a few solid reasons why you might want to give one a shot:

1) Work with your hands (while still running the company.)



Wouldn't it be great if you could run your company the way you want it, make the leadership decisions, and have top-down control over all your operations, while still being able to get into the field and get your hands dirty? Of course it would!

The problem is that any project that's big enough to get more than 2 people involved is going to require some coordination, planning, & leadership. And if you're the owner, the buck stops with you.

Deck projects are small and lean enough to turn around quickly, lucrative enough to build a business on, and common enough to find as many as you need. And since they're simple to estimate, and they only involve a couple of trades (more on that later), you can manage a project, run a company, and get out there framing a deck and breathing that sweet smell of construction in no time.

2) Plenty of work to go around, at great per-hour rates, for prospects who can afford it!

3) Fewer trades involved



Nothing fills up your calendar, bloats your project, torpedoed your bottom line, and moves you further away from the work faster than involving more than one or two tradesmen.

Keeping track of everybody's schedules, availability, and material needs quickly becomes a headache. And if one of them has a setback, your whole project slides back with them.

Deck projects are simpler! Only on the fanciest projects will you need to bring in an electrical or plumbing specialist (say for a hot tub, or outdoor kitchen), at which point the price point for the project will have increased to the point that you will easily recover the costs.

You can even include these trades at a profit for the relative simplicity of their roles, but only if you can afford the shift in time flexibility. Which brings us to...

4) More time flexibility on the job.

What are the perks of not having to deal with a drywall guy, a plumber, a painter, and an electrician on your job site?

You're more free to set your own schedule.



You know what's even better? The entire project is outside the homeowner's house! No need to work around little yappy dogs or expensive wardrobes & furniture like you would on an interior project!
